PAINTING



Learn surface preparation, coating systems and finishing techniques.

TILING



Gain skills in tile layout, cutting, setting and grouting.

WALL & CEILING LINING



Install plasterboard and finish walls and ceilings to industry standards.

SOLID PLASTERING



Learn hands-on plastering techniques and surface finishing skills.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This 20-week, full-time traineeship provides a pathway into construction through structured learning and paid practical experience. Participants build foundation trade skills and apply their knowledge in real work settings.

Participants also complete supervised practical activities at Wounded Heroes Equine Site – Heroes 4 Horses.

PROGRAM LOCATIONS

The program is held at two locations:

WACOL

No public transport. Participants must have their own transport to and from Wacol.

SALISBURY

Accessible by train.

WORK EXPERIENCE

Participants must also have their own transport during Work Experience.

EQUINE THERAPY EXPERIENCE



Each week, participants spend time with the horses, learning to feed and care for them. The experience helps build confidence, resilience and wellbeing.
